The grievance of the petitioners is that one Virender Singh (son of petitioner No.1 and brother of petitioner No.2) has made a complaint dated 3.8.2018 at the NRI Police Station, Ludhiana City and thereafter, the petitioners have been asked to join investigation on a number of dates. Their house has also been raided and it is likely that an FIR would be registered and they would be arrested. It is submitted that the complaint is in respect of a family dispute and that under the circumstances, their arrest would not be justified.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice. Let four copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Keeping in view the nature of order being passed, no reply is necessary to be filed.
