Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to protect/safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioner who has threat at the hands of respondent No. 4.

Perusal of petition reveals that civil litigation between the parties is already pending. According to the petitioner, an agreement to sell dated 08.11.2017 of property was executed by respondent No.4 in favour of the petitioner. However, instead of honouring the same, another agreement to sell dated 07.05.2018 was executed by respondent No. 4 in favour of a third party. A suit for injunction was filed by the petitioner before the Civil Court, however, the interim relief of injunction was declined.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4

contended that averments made in the petition are regarding the dispute between the parties for which the parties are already before the Civil Court.

Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the alleged representation dated 31.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) was never received by the police, this Court does not find any reason to invoke the jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Since the dispute is civil in nature and parties are already litigating before the Civil Court. Therefore, this petition fails and same is hereby dismissed.
