Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner, in FIR No.0010 dated 03.02.2019, under Sections 20, 61, 85 of Narcotoc Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra.

As per prosecution case, 1 kg. 600 grams of *ganja* was recovered from the possession of the petitioner without having any permit or licence.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Surender Singh has apprised the Court that petitioner is already facing two other criminal cases under the provisions of NDPS Act, apart from third one under the Excise Act.

In view of above, this Court is not inclined to grant the petitioner concession of bail pending trial at this stage.

Petition stands dismissed. Needless to say that observations made above may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
