ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.44 dated 08.05.2017, under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail by the trial Court and he could not appear before the trial Court on 03.12.2018 as he was unwell. He has referred to the medical certificate in this regard which is annexed as Annexure P-3.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 20.03.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Angrej Singh, states that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail in terms of the order dated 20.03.2019

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the order dated 20.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
