The instant petition has been filed seeking to challenge the order dated 10.10.2000 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Kurukshetra whereby a sum of ₹81,500/- had been allowed in a claim filed under Section 66 of the Motor Vehicles Act.

A perusal of the orders passed in this case would reflect that no one has put in an appearance on behalf of the appellant.

This case is on the board of this Court and since no one has put in appearance on behalf of learned counsel for the appellant, it was ordered that notice be issued to the learned counsel for the appellant for 27.02.2019. The office noting would reflect that the letter sent to learned counsel for the appellant-Mr. Jagat Singh, Advocate has been received back served. However despite service, there is no representation on behalf of learned counsel for the appellant. In such a situation, this case is dismissed for non-

prosecution, leaving it open to the appellant to move an appropriate application within a period of three months as on date, for recalling of the order with sufficient explanations as to why this matter was unattended.
