By virtue of the compromise arrived at between the parties in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court in RSA No.5818 of 2017, the parties had agreed to transfer the land of Miyan Singh and Miyan Singh, would further execute the Will, in favour of Sagar, grandson.

Assailing the inaction on the part of the parties, the present contempt petition has been filed.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, I am of the view that the remedy for the petitioner would be to recall the order of compromise by revival of RSA No.5818 of 2017, instead of alleging willful disregard as there is no direction of this Court.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty of this Court to withdraw the present contempt petition.
