GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.63 dated 11.9.2015 under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC, Police Station Airport, District Amritsar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide orders dated 31.7.2018 & 8.2.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Sahil Masih & injured-Mandeep Singh have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant & injured have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Magistrate that compromise is genuine and without any pressure or undue influence of the parties.
4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.63 dated 11.9.2015 under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC, Police Station Airport, District Amritsar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
