Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for directing the official respondents to complete the investigation in cross-case bearing DDR No.38 dated 31.08.2013 (**P-1**), under Sections 307, 336, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, recorded in FIR No.160 dated 30.08.2013 (**P-2**), under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Paper-book reveals that during the pendency of the present petition, the investigation was completed by the police and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been submitted.

This Court, vide order dated 09.07.2018, directed the State to file a detailed affidavit as to why there is delay of more than 04 years in presenting the challan.

In terms of above order, detailed affidavit dated 29.09.2018 of S.I. Gulzar Singh has already been filed. The same is taken on record.

It has been sufficiently explained in the affidavit that the delay in submission of challan was not intentional, but due to the circumstances explained therein and the same is satisfactory.

Since now the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. stands already presented and the grievance of the petitioners has been redressed, therefore, no further directions are required to be issued in the present case.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed off.

Ordered accordingly.
