Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 25.12.2018 (Annexure P-10), whereby his claim for appointment on compassionate grounds has been rejected. Stand of the petitioner is that his father was injured in an accident on 13.12.2014, due to which he was incapacitated to some extent to unable him to walk and perform other duties. Petitioner seeks compassionate appointment on this ground. His plea has been rejected by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka on the ground that there is no prevalent instructions to give compassionate appointment in such circumstances.

During the course of hearing, counsel for the petitioner has also not been able to point out any rules or instructions, which entitle him to be considered for such appointment. Petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
