HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

In the present writ petition, charge sheet dated 31.8.2018 (Annexure P/3) issued to the petitioner after his retirement is under challenge.

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed reply on behalf of Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation (PUNSUP), wherein, it has been stated that no departmental enquiry will be undertaken in respect of the charge sheet for imposing punishment upon the petitioner and the allegations alleged in the charge sheet, will only be enquired as fact finding enquiry and in case any allegation is proved against the petitioner in the fact finding enquiry and any action is to be taken against him with regard to any recovery, the same will be done by filing a civil suit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the

reply filed on behalf of the respondents in the Court today, she does not wish to press the present writ petition any further but a liberty be granted to the petitioner to claim the pensionary benefits, which have been withheld by the respondents in pursuance to the said charge sheet, which is now not to be treated as pending for holding disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner claiming pensionary benefits, which have been withheld after his retirement, an appropriate order will be passed within a period of two months from the date of receipt of said representation and in case there is no impediment in the release of the benefits, the same will be released within a period of one month thereafter.

The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed in above terms.

In view of the order passed today, all the miscellaneous applications stand disposed of as infructuous.
