The petitioners rice mills have approached this Court for issuance of directions to the respondent-Food Corporation of India, to accept the custom milled rice so as to ensure compliance of the delivery scheduled as contained under Clause 20 (v) of the Custom Milling Policy 2018-19 (Annexure P-1).

It is the submission made by counsel that stock paddy entrusted to the petitioner rice mills has been milled and it is only on account of shortage of space with the Food Corporation of India that delivery is not being accepted.

In the light of such short grievance raised in the petition and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to examine the issue against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 11.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) and to thereafter take remedial steps as deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
