Reply to the petition has been filed today in the Court. Same is taken on record.

Prayer in the petition is to extend the parole which was granted for carrying out the agricultural work.

It has been pleaded that unmarried sister of the petitioner had died on 18.03.2019. It is not disputed by the learned counsel that sister who has died has already been cremated and the petitioner being on parole was able to attend the cremation. However, counsel submits that he has to attend the last rites which are likely to be held on 01.04.2019 in the village at District Rohtak.

Mr. Jagjit Singh, ASI, who is present in the Court has submitted

that the village is 10-12 KM from the jail premises and petitioner can very well be taken to the village while being in custody on that day enabling him to attend the last rites.

Keeping in view the aforeaid facts, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Superintendent of Jail, Rohtak to make an arrangement to take the petitioner in police vehicle with adequate protection to the place where last rites of the sister are to take place on the date to be intimated by the petitioner.
