This is an application for early hearing of the main petition.

As the main petition is listed today, therefore, the instant application has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

CRM M-25617-2018

The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.182 dated 12.11.2017, registered under Sections 420, 498-A IPC, at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 state that now the compromise has been effected between the parties and petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has

joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 28.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

However, the Registry is directed to return the bank draft No.302948 dated 18.09.2018 for an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- to the petitioner for revalidation. The petitioner is also directed that after the revalidation of the bank draft, the same be deposited before the court below who will hand over the same to respondent No.2-complainant Kawaljit Kaur against proper receipt and identification.
