ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.255 dated 29.10.2014, registered under Section 420 of IPC and Sections 63/69 of Copyright Act, 1957 and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Bhagwant Singh, has submitted that the police is yet to conclude its investigation and therefore, the petition is pre-mature.

On the other hand, learned senior counsel for the petitioner points out that the present petition is pending in this Court for the last four years and inspite of various directions issued, police has failed to conclude the investigation.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, the present petition is disposed of by directing the Investigating Agency to conclude the investigation within three months from today. Needless to observe that the petitioner, if still aggrieved, shall be at liberty to file a fresh one.
