The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 30.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 29718 of 2018

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“Petition is hereby disposed of. In case petitioner sends a fresh copy of the legal notice/representation to the concerned authority alongwith a copy of this order by registered/speed post, the authority shall pass a speaking order at the earliest, in any case not later than six weeks of receipt thereof. If any amount is found due to the petitioner, payment of same be released after sanction from the Finance Department, if required. “

Learned State counsel has placed on record the copy of order dated 08.07.2019 whereby, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected. Copy of the same be supplied to the counsel for petitioner.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the order has been complied with, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

The rule issued against the respondents is discharged.

Disposed of as infructuous.

However, if there is any grievance against the order dated 08.07.2019, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
