The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 60, dated 30.4.2015, registered at Police Station C Division, Amritsar, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 382, 148 and 149 IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 01.10.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received to the effect that statement of complainant Satish Malhotra @

Bittu, injured Avinash Kumar and also of petitioners/accused Jangi, Khula, Pankaj, Raj Kumar, Suraj and Rahul have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant as well as the injured have specifically stated that they have no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar opined that the compromise arrived between the parties is without any pressure, coercion, undue influence and out of their own free will. However, petitioner No.7-Karan has not come present before the learned Court below.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 60, dated 30.4.2015, registered at Police Station C Division, Amritsar, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 382, 148 and 149 IPC and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners No.1 to 6. The petition qua petitioner No.7-Karan is dismissed, with liberty to move afresh.
