The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that although as per the entry in the revenue record, area of khasra No.24/2, Rect.No.41 situated at village Darba Kalan, Tehsil Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa is 05 Kanals and 07 Marlas but as per field book and the measurement book (Masavi), area at the spot comes to 03 Kanals and 16 Marlas. He contends that total area which was allotted to the petitioner in the partition proceedings was 44 Kanals and 16 Marlas whereas because of wrong entry in the revenue record, the petitioner has actually on the spot, got 01 Kanal and 05 Marlas of land less as compared to his entitlement.

Highlighting this aspect, the petitioner has filed representations dated 27.09.2018 and 04.12.2018 (Annexures P-8 & P-9) respectively, to the competent authority i.e. The District Revenue Officer-cum Assistant Collector, 1st Class, Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa, respondent No.3 but without any response.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3- The District

Revenue Officer-cum Assistant Collector, 1st Class, Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa to consider and take a decision on the representation as submitted by the petitioner within a specified period.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting on its merits, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- The District Revenue Officer-cum Assistant Collector, 1st Class, Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa to consider and decide the representations dated 27.09.2018 and 04.12.2018 (Annexures P-8 & P-9) respectively, submitted by the petitioner preferably within a period of eight months. Decision so taken thereon, be conveyed to the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of.
