ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.195 dated 27.11.2018 under Sections 395/201 IPC, registered at Police Station Garhi, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that the petitioner alongwith co-accused had snatched the purse of the complainant containing ₹49,820/-. Recovery of ₹ 4800/- is alleged to have been effected from the petitioner. He is in custody for over 6 months since his arrest on 29.11.2018 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar Singh, states that 5 out of 14 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially, when investigation has been completed and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
