This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.76 dated 1.8.2018 registered under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC, 1860 at police station Mehana, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the merits of the case and the period of custody, the petitioner is very keen to settle this dispute with the complainant and in case he had been granted interim bail for four weeks, he would be able to settle this dispute.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Virender Singh has accepted this suggestion and states that this is a case where the petitioner obtained money from the complainant to send him abroad.

In the circumstances, prayer for grant of bail is declined and it is directed that the petitioner be released on interim bail for 30 days subject

to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate. In case the dispute is settled within the said period the Trial Court shall confirm the bail.

The petition stands disposed of with the abovementioned observation.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
