This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 18 dated 7.2.2019 registered under Sections 147, 149, 283 IPC, Section 8 B of National Highways Act, 1956, Section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 at PS Naggal, District Ambala.

The allegations against the petitioners are that petitioners alongwith some other persons were blocking the road and when the officials of the National Highway Authority of India reached there they saw that the petitioners were demanding construction of over bridge or underpass because due to absence of the same accidents takes place there everyday. During that time a Haryana Roadways bus was passing by and 'some persons' brick batted the same.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in

view the facts the circumstances of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the petitioners concession of anticipatory bail. Consequently, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest they will be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and as and when their presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
