**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.464 dated 21.11.2018, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act registered at Police Station Gohana Sadar, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that after search of the car being driven by the petitioner 510 grams of charas was recovered which is less than the threshold of commercial quantity of 1 kg. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody since 21.11.2018 and he is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Navendra Singh states that the *challan* has been filed on 11.01.2019 and the matter is now fixed for framing of charges.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the recovery is of non-commercial quantity, the petitioner being in custody for over 4½ months and not involved in any other case, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Sombir is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
