Petitioner is stated to be a Depot Holder.

Instant petition has been filed raising a grievance that official respondents No.4 and 5 who happen to be the Food Supply Officer, Ajnala, District Amritsar and Assistant Food Supply Officer, Ajnala, District Amritsar, have issued threats for getting deport licence of the petitioner cancelled. Further a mandamus is sought for the official respondents to follow the mandate under Section 24 of the National Food Security Act, 2013.

Counsel submits that inspite of the requisite deposit having been made, the necessary wheat stocks is not being delivered and the petitioner is being harassed.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

The instant petition raises questions of fact.

This Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction would not be inclined to embark into a roving enquiry into the matter.

In the considered view of this Court, the petitioner ought to approach the higher authorities i.e. the Principal Secretary, Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab, as regards his grievance and by furnishing necessary and cogent details.

Writ petition is disposed of in terms of the liberty as observed herein above.

It is clarified that this Court has not gone into the merits of this case.
