The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

On 29.03.2019, State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In deference to the order dated 29.03.2019, learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Vijender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Panipat on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 wherein it is specifically mentioned that statements of respondents No. 4 to 6 have been recorded wherein they assured that they will not cause any hurt to the life and personal liberty of the petitioners. The said statement are given voluntarily by the private respondents. Apart from this, no specific source or mode of threat is mentioned in the representation given by the applicants (petitioners).

In view of the reply filed by the State and the stand of the father of petitioner No.2, who is present in Court, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
