Petitioner Balvir Kaur has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.34 dated 05.03.2019, registered at Police Station City Kotakpura, District Faridkot, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR has been got registered by complainant Prem Maini, who stated that his son, who was citizen of Canada was married with Annie daughter of Satish Chand. The present petitioner is the mother of Annie and it appears that it is a case of matrimonial dispute.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 20.03.2019, passed by

this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 20.03.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
