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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)**

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 12, dated 11.1.2015, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 420, 506, 467, 468 and 471 IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 19.1.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran has been received to the effect that statement of complainants-Tara Singh, Davinder Singh Goraya, Maninder Singh, Gurpreet Singh, Sukhwinder

Singh, Narinder Singh, Sher Singh, Jaswant Singh Gill, Dr. Gurmit Singh Sandhu, Jagdip Singh and Nirvail Singh and also of petitioner/accused Kulwinder Singh Alhuwalia have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainants have specifically stated that they have no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran opined that the compromise arrived between the parties appears to be genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 12, dated 11.1.2015, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 420, 506, 467, 468 and 471 IPC and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
