Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner no.2 in case FIR No.32 dated 09.05.2018 under Section 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn *qua* petitioner no.1 vide order dated 14.06.2018.

Learned counsel for petitioner no.2 states that pursuant to order dated 14.06.2018 of this Court, petitioner no.2 has joined investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh,
does not dispute the facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner no.2 has joined
investigation and her custody is no more required, the present petition is
allowed and the interim order dated 14.06.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner no.2 shall join the investigation as and
when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and
conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
