This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.148 dated 08.04.2018 registered under Sections 379-A, 201, 34 IPC at P.S. Rai, District Sonipat, Haryana.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody for the last almost 11 months.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 08.04.2019 by Shahid Hussain - Dsp-2, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Sonipat, Haryana is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone 10 months and 24 days of custody.

Learned Assistant Advocate General on instructions from ASI

Rajinder has accepted the above said factual assertions but states that the

petitioner is involved in other cases as well.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/CJM/trial Court/Duty Magistrate. It is, however, clarified that in case the petitioner does not submit bail bonds, he would not be entitled to count the custody in this case.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
