GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.30 dated 10.03.2019 under Sections 295-A of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 26.3.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Budhlada has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioner as well as of complainants-Deepak Kumar, Sanjiv Kumar Singla and Sanjiv Kumar have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainants have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Budhlada that compromise appears to be genuine and without any pressure or coercion.
4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.30 dated 10.03.2019 under Sections 295-A of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
