The present petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty as the petitioners fear that respondents No.4 to 9 (relatives of petitioner No.1) will cause them bodily harm as their marriage has been performed against their wishes.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Lalit K. Gupta, Addl. P.P. U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let 04 copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day. At this stage, there is no requirement of issuing notice to respondents No.4 to 9.

Petitioners No.1 & 2 are major and the same is proved by their Aadhaar Cards (P-1 & P-2).

In view of above, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioners is protected by providing them adequate protection after carrying out a threat assessment and as and when deemed appropriate. The representation (Annexure P-4) already made as well as the facts mentioned in this petition shall be kept in mind by him.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
