This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detenue Ritu, who is illegally detained by respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Notice of motion was issued. Respondent No.3-SHO was directed to visit the residences of private respondent Nos.4 and 5 and to enquire into as to whether detenue Ritu has been illegally detained against her wishes and if it is found so, then she be produced immediately before this court. Otherwise, a detailed report be submitted on the next date of hearing.

Reply has also been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State. The statement of the detenue has also been recorded which is annexed with the reply.

Alleged detenue-Ritu is present in the Court and states that

petitioner No.1 Rajesh Saini is her husband and he used to harass her, so she left the house of her husband and is residing with her father's sister Saroj at her own and is not being illegally detained by anybody.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioners are directed to deposit compensation of ₹10,000/- as costs within one month before the ld. CJM, Sonapat which shall be paid to detenue as per law.

It is made clear that if the petitioners fail to deposit the costs within the stipulated period, then ld. CJM, Sonapat is directed to get it recovered as arrears of land revenue from the petitioners to be paid to the detenue as per law.
