Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.18 dated 26.01.2019 under Sections 364, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 325, 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

While granting interim bail to petitioner No.2, following order was passed by this Court on 29.03.2019:-

“.....Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.1 Kewal Singh and petitioner No.3 Manjit Singh and submits that a

direction be issued to the trial Court to decide their bail application expeditiously.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioners No.1 & 3.

In case petitioners No.1 & 3 surrender before the Investigating Officer within a period of 07 days from today, the trial Court is directed to decide their regular bail application(s) within a period of 04 days thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.2 Harpreet Singh @ Sukha was not attributed any serious injury except that he caught hold of the complainant.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position and states that petitioner No.2 is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to petitioner No.2 Harpreet Singh @ Sukha vide order dated 29.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
