The petitioners are working on group-C posts i.e. Electrician, Carpenter and Plumber, etc. and are getting salary of Rs.15,400/- p.m. and some of the petitioners are working on group-D posts i.e. Beldar, Sweeper, Chowkidar and Helper etc. and are getting salary of Rs. 13,400/- p.m. They are claiming minimum of the regular pay scale keeping in view the judgment passed by this Court in *Civil Appeal No. 213 of 2013 State of Punjab V/s. Jagjit Singh*, decided on 26.10.2016. After this judgment, notification has been issued on 03.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) giving direction to all the Departments to implement the principle of 'equal pay for equal work'.

Representations dated 18.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) and dated 09.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) have been made by the petitioners in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

This petition is being disposed of, at this stage, by giving direction to respondents to look into the representations, judgment passed by this Court *CWP-16954-2015 Anurag Chahal V/s. State of Haryana and*

another (Annexure P-4) and full bench judgment passed by this Court in *CWP-14050-1999 Vijay Sharma V/s. State of Punjab* (Annexure P-5) and the Supreme Court judgment passed in *Civil Appeal No. 213 of 2013 State of Punjab V/s. Jagjit Singh* (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
