The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 08.10.2018 passed in CWP No. 16867 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is quoted below:-

“ In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the Enquiry Officer, before whom the enquiry is pending now, to dispose of the enquiry proceedings within four months.”

Pursuant to the notice, reply was filed.

Learned State counsel submits that the order of this Court has been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the enquiry report has not been supplied.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from Mr. Angrej Singh, BDO, Indri, submits that the enquiry report would be supplied to the petitioner as well as counsel for the petitioner within one week from today.

In view of reply as well as statement made above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

It is made clear that in case the afore-said statement is not adhered to, petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition and in case petitioner is forced to revive the same, costs may be imposed which shall be recovered from the defaulting official/officer.
