The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.25 dated 28.02.2019 registered under Sections 376/506/323 IPC at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana.

It has been submitted that petitioner and complainant were residing in live-in-relationship. Due to some misunderstanding, complaint was lodged. Now compromise has been effected between the parties.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined

the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more

required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 26.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
