The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.122 dated 26.04.2018, registered under Sections 376-B and 377 IPC, at Police Station Industrial Area, Phase-I, Chandigarh.

The petitioner as well as complainant alongwith their counsel have appeared in person before this Court. Both the parties state that now the compromise has been effected between them and petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed for grant of divorce by mutual consent.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of the case and considering the fact that both the parties have now settled their dispute

amicably, this court deems it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 20.06.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
