Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Karansher Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-II, Bathinda, District Bathinda was filed. Perusal of the preliminary submissions No. 2 and 3 reads as under:

'2. That on the application dated 4.6.2018 moved by abovesaid Gurtej Singh Bahia, the matter was being enquired by ASI Manjit Singh PS Civil Lines, Bathinda, on the same day the petitioner moved an application against the respondent No.5 for registration of case FIR under Section 376,

506 IPC. So both the applications were enquired by ASI Manjit Singh and during the inquiry, statements were recorded and from the footage of CCTV Camera installed in the street which leads to the office of respondent no.5, it transpired that the application moved by the petitioner is false one and in this regard DDR No. 32 dated 10.06.2018 was entered.

3. That thereafter the respondent No.3 conducted inquiry and after going through the facts of the case it was found that the petitioner alongwith Jatinder Kumarr @ Gagann Sodhi competitor of respondent no.5, Honey @ Money, Jaswinder Kaur and Manjeet Kaur had committed offence of extortion and cheating by forming a Gang and in this regard DDR No. 28 was entered on 18.06.2018 and above said case was registered against the petitioner, Jaswinder Kaur, Manjit Kaur, Honey @ Money and Jatinder Kumarr alias Gagann Sodhi on the application of Gurtej Singh Stark Security service, Dr. Pas Wali Gali, Power House Road, Bathinda and no offence under Section 376, 506 IPC was found against the said Gurtej Singh respondent No.5. The petitioner was arrested on 22.08.2018 with regard to the FIR No. 130/2018 and now has been released on bail by the Court of Sh. Gurmeet Tiwana, PCS, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda vide order dated

26.09.2018.

It is further submitted that the co-accused Jatinder Kumar @ Gagan Sodhi in the above said FIR is also accused in case FIR No. 251 dated 8.12.2017 under Section 420, 384, 494, 211, 120-B, Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda and the case is under investigation. It is further made clear that the above said case FIR No.251 has been registered on the same facts as of the facts of the present case.

It is, therefore, prayed that the present writ petition may kindly be dismissed in the interest of justice.'

It is further mentioned that allegations levelled by the petitioner were found to be totally false and she is trying to extort the money from the innocent public.

In view of the above, no directions are required to be issued in the matter and the same is hereby dismissed.

It is clarified that petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedies available under law, if so advised.

The observations made above may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the DDR's and FIR's reproduced hereinabove.
