On 26.03.2019, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier the petitioner was released on bail being the bailable offences and was appearing before the Court regularly. Thereafter challan was presented and charges were also framed. The petitioner could not appear on 5.12.2018 as wrong date was noted down. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and undertake to abide by all the terms and conditions to be imposed by this Court or by the trial Court.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. In case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within the stipulated period,

he shall be released on interim bail to its satisfaction.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner pursuant to the direction, has appeared and sought bail, which has been granted and now the petitioner would regularly appear before the trial Court.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of.
