FIR No. 54 dated 20.10.2018 has been registered against the petitioner and others at Police Station STF Phase IV Mohali under Sections 21, 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985. Currently the petitioner is on regular bail.

According to the FIR, vehicle bearing No. '9214' was reportedly carrying some contraband,. A naka was established and vehicle bearing No. '9214' was intercepted. The petitioner and his co-accused were arrested and some contraband was recovered from him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the vehicle which has been recovered was purchased by brother of the petitioner and its actual registration No. is '9412'. The police is likely to add the offence of forgery against the petitioner and arrest him again. The next date of hearing before the trial Court is 25.03.2019 and it is apprehended that the petitioner will be arrested on the said date of hearing.

of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to give three days notice to the petitioner under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. in case an additional offence is to be added against the petitioner in the FIR.
