The petitioner has approached this court for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect her life and liberty. Allegedly, her parents i.e. respondents No.4 & 5 are pressurizing her to get married, whereas, she wants to continue her studies being a brilliant student. It is further submitted that she left her parents house on 30.10.2018 and started living with some friends in Mohali. Presently, she is residing in a PG accommodation in Sector 22, Chandigarh.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts the notice on behalf of the respondents-State of Punjab. Let 04 copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed no necessity to issue notices to respondents No.4 & 5.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider her representation dated 05.03.2019. (P-7) and to

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take appropriate action thereupon as may be found necessary, within 02 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Meanwhile, the life and liberty of the petitioner shall be protected and the petitioner shall be entitled to approach respondents No.2 & 3 at any time for the said relief.
