This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Surjeet Kaur in case bearing FIR No.11 dated 21.02.2018 registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga under Sections 406, 498-A, 120-B IPC.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Bhagwan Singh, PS Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga, submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 20.06.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations during which she has been found to be innocent and that she is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.06.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, she will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
