This order shall dispose of CRM-M-13767-2019, filed by

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petitioner-Labh Singh and CRM-M-17935-2019, filed by petitioner-Harkamal Singh alias Soni, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.77 dated 19.10.2016, registered at Police Station Kot Bhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 302, 307, 379, 436, 336, 427, 324, 323, 148, 149 and 120 of the IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested both these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that both the petitioners are named by the injured in this case. It is a triple murder case and so many persons have received fire-arm injuries.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that there is every chance of tampering with the evidence, if the petitioners are released on bail, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioners are entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petitions, the same are dismissed.
