Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.985 dated 03.10.2018, under Sections 120-B, 408 & 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Model Town Panipat, District Panipat.

On 26.03.2019, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Contends that neither the petitioner has been named in the FIR; nor anything is to be recovered from him. Further contends that as a matter of fact, the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of disclosure statement by one of the co-accused as a counter-blast to CWP No.22178 of 2018 (P-2), filed by the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 01.05.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)

Cr.P.C.”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 26.03.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from HC Devinder, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required in the present case.

In view of the above, the order dated 26.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
