On 26.03.2019, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two co-accused namely Surender Kashyap and Vijay Kumar filed two different petitions against whom the same allegations are there and they have been granted interim anticipatory bail. The petitioner is also ready to deposit 1/3rd of the total amount of ` 74,000/- before the Registry of this Court as deposited by co-accused Vijay Kumar.

Notice of motion for 10.04.2019.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.12324 of 2019.

Interim order in the same terms as passed in CRM-M No.12324 of 2019, subject to deposit of the amount.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kulbir Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation. Learned counsel for the State has also informed that the cancellation report has been prepared, which is pending for approval from the superior authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that pursuant

to interim order dated 18.03.2019, passed by this Court in CRM-M-12324 of 2019, certain amount has been deposited by the petitioner.

Since, the police is proposing to file cancellation report, therefore, let the amount be remitted to the concerned Magistrate who would pass appropriate orders while examining the cancellation report, if any filed, in accordance with law.

In view thereof, interim order dated 26.03.2019 passed by this court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
