This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.78 dated 26.02.2019 registered under Sections 406/506/34 IPC at Police Station NIT Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner and counsel for the complainant state that the matter has been compromised.

Learned State counsel has very fairly stated that in that event he would not oppose the grant of anticipatory bail.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is

allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 27.05.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
