Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.022 dated 08.02.2019 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

The petitioner is in custody as he is alleged to have been found in possession of 510 capsules of Parvorinsps Tramadol, Hydrochloride Diclofenac Sodium, Dicyclomine Hydrochloride Chlorpheniramine Maleate.

ASI Ishwar Singh, Investigating Officer present in Court has admitted that the challan has been presented and the petitioner is not involved in any other case registered under NDPS Act. He further admits that the prosecution intends to examine 12 witnesses, however, none has been examined. The petitioner is in custody since 08.02.2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
