Petitioner has sought emergency parole for four weeks for admission of his daughter Vanishka Hudda from KG to First class in Aggarwal Public School, Machgar, Ballbgarh, Faridabad.

Reply by State already filed. Today, short reply filed in Court and same is taken on record. The school has submitted report that Vanishka Hudda is student of First class. She was admitted in KG class in their school. As per school rules, presence of father is necessary, but in case of non presence of father, then mother or guardian of child can be present in school and made necessary process for admission.

Since presence of petitioner is absolutely not necessary for admission of his child, therefore, there is no ground to grant emergency parole to petitioner. Petition is dismissed.
