Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-31) passed by the learned Civil Court, Nabha dismissing the application dated 27.11.2017 (Annexure P-29) of the petitioner.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that she may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to assail the order passed by the Civil Court or to take recourse to the alternative remedies as are available to it, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
