The petitioner was granted 42 days parole which expires on 27.3.2019. He filed the present petition for extension of the parole on the ground that his father has suffered a paralytic attack on 13.3.2019.

This Court has directed that the petitioner need not surrender till today. In this way, the petitioner has already got the extension of one week. The parole was granted by the District Magistrate. Therefore, if the petitioner wants extension of parole, he should move before the same authority. Now the petitioner is granted one day to surrender before the jail authorities i.e. by 5.4.2019.
