The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in DDR No.37 dated 3.7.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC (offence under Sections 325 & 326 IPC added subsequently) arising out of main case i.e. FIR No.58 dated 3.7.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners in the FIR are that Manga Ram (Petitioner No.1) had given a blow with the iron rod on the right flank of the complainant and Parambir Singh (Petitioner No.2) had given blows with a stick to the complainant and his brother. He, however, contends that the petitioner No.1 himself had received 4 injuries in the occurrence and an FIR No.58 dated 3.7.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC was lodged at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar in this regard.

This Court, by the order dated 01.05.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 01.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
