Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners in view of the marriage solemnized by them against the wishes of respondent Nos.5 to 7.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. C.L.Pawar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 and requisite sets of paper-book be supplied to him during the course of day.

4. Petitioner No.1 is claiming her date of birth as 17.01.1983 on the basis of her Middle Standard Examination Certificate and Aadhaar Card (P-1 colly.), whereas petitioner No.2 is claiming his date of birth as 07.05.1987 on the basis of his Passport (P-2). The documents annexed by the petitioners show that both are major and are present in Court also, duly identified by their Counsel. They apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7. Therefore, the present petition is

disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2/Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, as per law.

5. However, it is made clear that this order may not be construed as expression of an opinion on legality and validity of the marriage of the petitioners.

6. In case, any criminal case is pending against petitioner No.2, this order shall not be any hindrance to proceed according to law.
